notebook to take notes in (three-ring binder is best)  
graphing calculator

**Physiology (10<sup>th</sup> grade Main Lesson), Zoology (11<sup>th</sup> grade Main Lesson), Evolution (12<sup>th</sup> grade Main Lesson)**

notebook  
folder  
pen / pencil

**College Biology**

binder or spiral notebook  
folder (one that closes with a fastener and holds a large number of papers)  
pencils and pens  
calculator  
graph paper

**Math (for all daily math courses and math Main Lessons)**

three-ring binder or spiral notebook dedicated to Math only  
folder dedicated to Math only  
paper – graph and lined, 8.5” x 11”  
pencils - #2 lead and colored - mechanical ok (mechanical needed for Projective Geometry Main Lesson)  
erasers  
Drafting Set – compass; 12” transparent flat graph ruler; 180-degree protractor; 45 and 60 degree triangles  
calculator – TI 83/84 graphing calculator

**11th & 12th grade Computer Science**

3-ring binder or spiral notebook w/ pockets  
lined and/or graph paper  
pens and/or pencils for notetaking  
calculator (optional)

**French**

separate notebook  
pens

**German grades 10-11**

ruler  
colored pencils or fine markers or colored ink pens  
one-inch binder  
lined paper  
pocket-sized German dictionary  
composition notebook to record vocabulary (you can continue using the one you have)  
optional: index cards and box to hold them

**German grade 12**

-1- pocket folder  
-1- notebook for taking notes in class  
-1- German/English dictionary  
-1- lined journal for diary entries

**Spanish**

a separate notebook for Spanish (keep the one from previous year if you started one)  
a set of flashcards  
colored pencils or different color highlighters  
pen / pencil  
one-inch binder  
recommended: English- Spanish dictionary to keep at home

**English as a New Language (ENL)**

one-inch binder / notebook  
pen / pencil
